

International Mobility of Researchers — MSCA— IF - Objective of the Call

 To develop human resources in research by supporting quality projects approved at the European level from Horizon 2020, the Marie Skłodowska-Curie Actions (2019) that are included in the "no-money" list. The main aim is to support a professional growth of researchers, to support quality research, education for practice, development of communication and cooperation. Support will be given only to European Fellowship projects.



Eligible activities

- Activity 1: Support of "no money" MSCA projects arrivals to CZ
- Activity 2: Support of "no money" MSCA projects departures from CZ
- Support tool: Support for the researcher's family



Eligible activities

 Activities specifically include scientific-research stays of employees of the Beneficiary – the so-called mobility.

The duration of mobility (i.e. net work-stay of a researcher) must be at least 12 to 24 months at maximum.

For Activity No. 2 Support of "no money" MSCA projects - departures from CZ a mandatory return phase is specified. The return phase must take at least 6 months and relates to individual mobility.



Excluded activities

- Project implementation submitted into Horizon 2020- MSCA-Global fellowships.
- If a short-term secondment is integrated in the mobility of a researchers (as permissible by the conditions of Horizon 2020 MSCA-IF), which does not meet the conditions set out by the Managing Authority for the area of public aid this activity cannot be supported. The secondment cannot be removed from the activity as a whole, i.e. the activity as a whole is not eligible to financing from OP RDE.

OP RDE	Horizon 2020
Eligibility: only organisations for research and knowledge dissemination according to the definition of the Framework for State Aid in Research and Development and Innovation (2014/C 198/01) and based in the Czech Republic.	Organisations from both the academic and the non-academic sectors can receive funding, such as universities, research institutions, research infrastructures, businesses, and other socio-economic actors from all countries.
The Applicant/Beneficiary must co-finance the project using the methodology rules of co-financing European structural and investment funds in 2014–2020 programming period.	No co-financning neccessary.
Different cost based on seniority (junior and senior researcher).	Same funding regardless of seniority.
The researcher must be employed by the applicant/beneficiary institution for the entire duration of the mobility.	The researcher is always employed by the institution where they are doing their research.
For activities "departure from CZ" mandatory return phase must be implemented.	Return phase not neccessary.





Mandatory activities

 Activity 1 - The researchers must actively participate in a conference/seminar/workshop etc., organized by the institution, at least once during each 6 months of the mobility duration.

 Activity 2 -The researchers must participate in a conference/seminar/workshop etc., at least once during each 6 months of the mobility duration. It may be an event organized by other than host institution or if the event is organized by the host institution, it must be an international event.



Activity report

- A document that must be prepared by each researcher once a month during the entire duration of the mobility. Includes:
- Description of work in a given month
- Declaration of non-economic activity performance
- Interruption of work in a given month
- Total working time in a given month
- The Activity Report is part of the Project Implementation Report (project PIR) and serves to document the performed activity units.



Results from previous years

2017 - International Mobility for Researchers - MSCA - IF (2015, 2016)

- 16 projects awarded € 5 992 798 (160 007 719 CZK)
- 47 mobilities (MSCA-IF projects)

2018 - International Mobility for Researchers - MSCA – IF II (2017)

- 17 projects awarded € 4 318 351 (115 299 978 CZK)
- 36 mobilities (MSCA-IF projects)

2019 - International Mobility for Researchers - MSCA - IF III (2018)

- 20 projects awarded € 5 031 544 (134 342 220 CZK)
- 39 mobilities (MSCA-IF projects)

2020 - International Mobility for Researchers - MSCA - IF IV (2019)
